Clues are in bold. Where the clue is located comes next, *what item the clue is located on is in italics.*

1. **Go to the galley and find me hook, it's not hard to find if you're willing to look!** Kitchen, *Hook*
2. **Pirates don't often have a lot of free time to play, but occasionally we get a sports and exercise day.** Basketball hoop or sports court, *basketball hoop*
3. **My pet is a writhing sort of fellow, but you can often find him next to something large and yellow.** Octopus, *anything yellow you have.*
4. **Your next clue is a model of my prized sea faring vessel made just for you! For a pirate like me nothing less than the best will do!** On the refreshment table, *wooden ship*
5. **My scurvy lads and lasses ye must find a pile of sand and then ye'll find the hint that is sure to give you a hand! Anywhere that is easy to see.** *Container full of sand with plastic gold coins with the letters p,a,r,r,o,t that when arranged give the clue parrot, leading to the parrot skeleton.*
6. **Sadly my bird waited forever for ye scoundrels to arrive and that is why Polly is no longer alive.** *Parrot skeleton or print out of parrot skeleton*
7. **These tools of the piracy trade aren't for the faint of heart, but they won't be used against you if you'll each do your part!** *Gun or pirate swords*
8. **A pirate's gotta eat my friends but not just anything we wish; this handy tool helps many a pirate to catch entire schools of fish.** On the bulletin board or wall. *Fishing net (part of decor)*
9. **A pirate must look good to intimidate the men on the ships he takes, so this piece of clothing let's everyone know that he's no fake!** On a table or chair. *Pirate hat or scarf*

10. If you want to be a true pirate you need to fly, your terrifying black flag reaching for the sky. Wall/bulletin board. *Pirate flag*

11. A treasured clue I once hid away in a small room with toys not too far away . . . Window or door, *toy room*

12. You're getting closer Mateys but now you must find, the skull and bones I've hidden the next clue behind. Refreshment table, *skull decoration*

13. A pirate has no flashlights to light his way in the dark, so this handy invention often used at birthdays is where you'll find an important pirate mark! Refreshment table. *candle decoration or birthday candle on cake.*

14. Our littlest guest has the penultimate clue just ask the little sailor and he's sure to give it to you! *If your birthday boy or girl is a toddler, you can pin a clue on them or put it in their pocket. Just print out an extra of all the clues in case your little one loses it. Or skip this clue if you'd like!*

15. A treasure is found—where else—but in a hidden treasure box?! This one contains tasty gold coins, pearls, and other precious rocks. While that treasure chest is a tasty treat to share, look nearby it and you'll find your very own treasure near there! under the table holding the treasure box birthday cake, *a treasure box or wooden crate holding gift bags for kids to take home*
